Know what to look for so you will avoid becoming a victim.



Text message scams – also called “phishing” or “smishing” – often take the form of an alert requiring your immediate attention. Examples of scam calls can include:

- Fake bank fraud alerts claiming suspicious activity on your account
- Sham delivery notifications urging a click to reschedule a package
- Bogus prize notifications offering a reward after clicking a link
- Texts purporting to be from a utility company or government agency.

If you receive a suspicious text, do not reply and do not click any links. Immediately block the sender and delete the message. Rushville State Bank will never send text messages regarding your accounts.
