**Rushville State Bank MasterCard Debit Cards are now eligible to be enrolled in Mobile Wallets** such as

Apple Pay, Samsung Pay, Google Pay, and Fitbit Pay. Use your preferred device to make purchases securely with your Mobile Wallet at participating merchants in person or online.

Mobile Wallets replace your actual card number with a unique digital card number or token and this along with an identification number from your specific device, enhance the security of your mobile transactions. Transactions are additionally secured using a wallet-specific PIN or fingerprint entered on your device.

Using instructions from your device or APP, add your Rushville State Bank MasterCard Debit Card to the wallet after reading and agreeing to our terms and conditions. Some devices will require a call to the Bank to complete the enrollment of your card.



Purchases using the Mobile Wallet will be deducted from your account just as if you used your physical card and you are given the same MasterCard fraud protections as well.

**Our Online Banking and Mobile Banking has a new Deposit ReCap Feature** allowing users to not only view images of deposit slips from paper deposits made to their accounts, but now will allow users to view the items that were included in the deposit.



Items included with the deposit are listed below the image of the deposit ticket and you can simply click on each item to review images.

# Trust Department Money for College!!!

*New Donna Dace Stephens Scholarship and More*

Career educator and lifelong Schuyler County resident Donna Dace Stephens died in 2018. Her children, William T. Stephens, Nancy J. Stephens, and Julie Dace Murray established a scholarship through the Schuyler County Community Foundation to honor Donna's commitment to Rushville and to education. One \$4,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating RIHS senior majoring in education, paid \$1,000.00 per year of college for four years. Applicants must be majoring in education, have a 3.0 or higher-grade point average, be accepted at an accredited state university in Illinois, demonstrate financial need, and submit the completed application form with all required documents. The first award will be announced in May.

These scholarships are also offered by the Schuyler County Community Foundation:

**Joshua "J PHIL" Phillips Memorial Athletic Scholarship** - for seniors pursuing any field who participate in athletics plus other activities.

**Late Knight Cruisers Car Club Scholarship** - for higher education in the fields of auto mechanic technology, diesel technology, or auto body repair, with other fields considered

**Roger's Bakery Culinary Arts Scholarship** - for a student pursuing higher education in the culinary arts or baking fields or another vocational field as approved by donor

**Schuyler Jail Museum Arthur, Carrie and Mardelle Hinnners Scholarships** - for any field, one to a Schuyler County senior and one to a Schuyler County upperclassman

Scholarships available through the Schuyler County Education Foundation are:

**A Hand Up Scholarship** - for a graduating senior from Schuyler County who plans to attend vocational, career, or trade school

**Michael Lee Ward Scholarship** - for a Schuyler County senior attending the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign majoring in mathematics or the sciences

**Victor Wood Scholarship** - for a senior majoring in education

**Ruth Hollenback Scholarship** - for all Schuyler County applicants up to four years with application available in late May.

For applications and additional information, please contact either the Rushville State Bank Trust Department or the Rushville-Industry High School Office. Most of the scholarship awards will be announced during the Rushville-Industry High School Awards Ceremony on May 14.
