they include the names of pets, childhood friends, etc. There may also be postings that celebrate anniversaries, birthdays or class reunions.

This may be all the information a cyber-criminal needs to social engineer their way into your online accounts. Ensure your online accounts exclude any references to information that can be found in your social media websites.



When setting your security questions and answers that are used to change passwords on your online accounts or perform certain types of transactions, select those that would not be common information that cybercriminals would easily find in your social media accounts or other sources of public information.

If you are owed money for payroll, a benefit, or bonus, companies will be "allowed" to pay them in a same-day processing environment. Receipt of these types of credits/deposits to your account must be used to offset any withdrawal items from your account received during the same day.

> Starting in September 2017, if you call in a payment to your credit card company using your checking account information, that payment "may" be deducted from your account on the same day you make the call rather than a couple days in the future. Not all bill payees will process their payments in this fashion, but you need to be aware of the possibility of same-day processing to ensure you have adequate funds in your account to cover the payments.
