New ATMs to feature touch screens and enhanced security

The next time you stop by the bank to use our ATMs, you may find that they've undergone a transformation.

That's because we will be upgrading to a new generation of ATMs that will come with some cool new features. The new ATMs will feature touchscreens for improved user experience. Additionally, they will be equipped with Diebold's Easy Edge Card Reader system, which has been shown to be especially effective in thwarting so-called "skimming" fraud.

Although the new ATMs will boast these and other improvements, they will no longer be capable of receiving deposits; however, your friendly Rushville State Bank tellers are more than happy to assist you with ensuring that your funds find their way into your account, or you may use our night depository during non-business hours.

The new ATMs are slated to be installed by the end of this year.

Deposit your checks anytime, anywhere with Mobile Deposit

Mobile Deposit will take banking convenience to a whole new level, allowing you to deposit checks simply by taking a picture with your mobile device.

With Mobile Deposit, you'll be able to deposit a properly endorsed check that will be memo-posted to your account upon bank review and approval up until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. You can deposit up to five items per day, with a maximum daily amount of \$1,500.

There are no fees to use Mobile Deposit; the only requirement is that you be a current Mobile Banking user and have a mobile phone capable of taking pictures. We will announce when this service becomes available.

A Coverdell education savings account (Coverdell ESA) is a trust or custodial account set up in the United States solely for paying qualified education expenses for a designated beneficiary. This benefit applies not only to qualified higher education expenses, but also to qualified elementary and secondary education expenses.

Distributions are tax-free to the extent that they don't exceed the beneficiary's qualified education expenses. However, there are certain requirements governing how Coverdell ESAs are set up, as well as strict rules for how contributions and distributions are handled.

We are happy to welcome Ashleigh Rutledge to the Rushville State Bank family as a New Accounts representative.


